Hotel & Apartment Project Selection Sheet

A practical decision aid for hospitality, multifamily and fitted-interior buyers.

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How should a hotel or apartment project select an ironing board?

Start with the installation location, available movement envelope, guest or resident use, housekeeping access, wall or cabinet structure, serviceability and the required project documentation. Select the mechanism only after these constraints are mapped.

Project condition	Recommended format	Why it fits	Confirm before specification
Fixed wall station; floor must remain clear	180° wall-mounted	Double folding and flexible left/right/angled positioning	Structural mounting, 950 mm working projection, installed height
Simple permanent wall station	Fold-down wall-mounted	Full 1070 × 300 mm surface; stores vertically	Wall reinforcement, clearance, cover service access
Ironing hidden in a wardrobe or closet	Cabinet built-in	Vertical storage and 180° horizontal positioning	449 mm minimum clear width, approx. 1480 mm vertical clearance, hinge interference
Ironing stored inside cabinet hardware	Folding pull-out	Pull-out rails, folding surface and up to 180° rotation	Approx. 500 × 350 × 110 mm stored footprint, drawer/door clearance
